



Mod Podge® Head Collage

OBJECTIVES

Students will...

- Create a collage using their imagination and creativity
- Learn to cut out shapes and experiment with their placement
- Recognize a collage as a work of art
- Work with a variety of shapes, surfaces, etc.

INSTRUCTIONS



STEP 1

Introduce students to collages and explain how they are visual art made from assembling different forms to create a new whole.

STEP 2

Give each student a Styrofoam® head, scissors, foam brush, some of the Mod Podge® medium, and paper. Students can use remnant paper, magazines, catalogs, or newspapers to cut out shapes, designs, words, or objects.

STEP 3

Students should experiment and plan where they want to attach and layer the cutouts to their Styrofoam® head.





STEP 4

To start the collage, apply some of the Mod Podge® medium directly onto the Styrofoam® head, then apply the desired cutout. Brush on more of the Mod Podge® medium on top of the cutout to make sure it will stay in the desired position.

STEP 5

Continue applying and layering the paper cutouts until the collage is complete.



STEP 6

When the collage is finished, coat the entire head with another full coat of the Mod Podge® medium and let dry completely.

5. What emotions did you experience while working on this project? What was the hardest and the easiest part of this process for you?

SELF-REFLECTION:

1. Did I try my best on this project?
2. How did I feel as I worked on this project?
3. What role does art play in my life?



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
